1. Two Systems Operate Side-By-Side

Australia today contains **two incompatible jurisdictions**:

A. The Lawful Commonwealth

- Under God
- Under the Crown
- Under Imperial & Common Law
- For the living men and women

B. The Corporate Administrative System

- Based on the Westphalian/Roman model
- Under statutes, policy, regulation
- For PERSONS, not people

They cannot mix.

Choosing the wrong one destroys standing.

- Presumed consent

3. The Danger of Confusion
